Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Serve as support teacher, working directly within the classroom (supervise toddlers, support in toileting and diaper changes, set up/clean up activities, including lunch and nap time, etc.)
- Support and maintain a culture of high behavioral and academic expectations rooted in liberatory practices that ensure every child is in a position to learn alongside peers and adults
